Course Mission:

Powerway's Quality Planner class is a 3-day course. The first two days of training are designed to provide a comprehensive review of the developmental tools and concepts needed to create and manage APQP documents. The third day of this class focuses on taking that new information and putting it to use by troubleshooting common problem scenarios. There are numerous information links in Quality Planner, many of which involve the creation of child documents from information found in their respective parent documents. If you do not create your parent documents correctly, the child documents will not exist. The third day of class offers the safest environment in which to learn from these mistakes.

Prerequisites:

Knowledge of the APQP Process and the documentation necessary for PPAP submittals.

Audience:

Quality planning core team members (e.g., quality managers, engineers, etc.).

- Learn how to track the five APQP steps: Planning, Product Design & Development, Process Design & Development, Product & Process Validation, and Production.
- Learn to create and edit APQP project documents, as well as gather & verify them for PPAP submittal.
- Learn how to configure and customize your APQP system.
- Gain an understanding of how Quality Planner controls and distributes documents.
- Learn how to create electronic binders for APQP project documents.
- Work in small groups to resolve and complete 16 problem scenarios for three separate projects. These are the most common problems that users create for themselves. The instructor will debrief the class after all groups have completed their scenarios.
- Learn how to export and import projects.
