Format:

Virtual classroom training via the Internet

Topics Covered:

- Overview of analyzing a process
- Configure Users and Groups in Powerway Desktop
- Assign SPC-related privileges to users and user groups
- Configure products for data collection:
 - Configure Products (name/number)
 - Configure Processes and process traceability
 - Configure Locations and location traceability
 - Configure Characteristic groups and Characteristics (variable and attribute)
- Product configuration check-in and approval
- Delete and Copy product configurations
- Configure and use Alarm groups
